Samyuktha B and Sarvesh Gopi, as the hosts of the programme, set the beginning of the assembly, seamlessly.

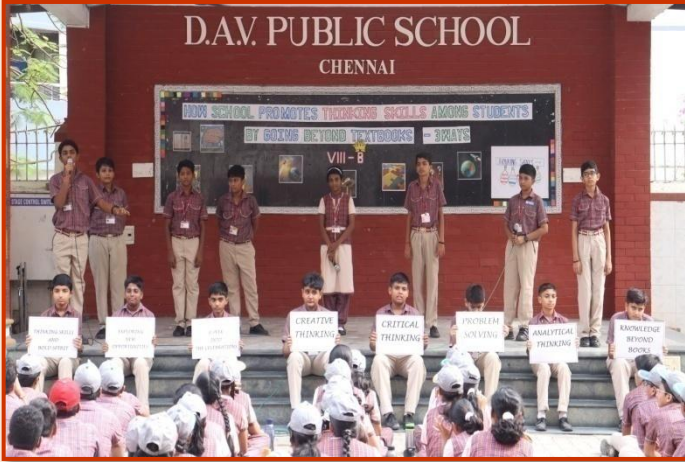

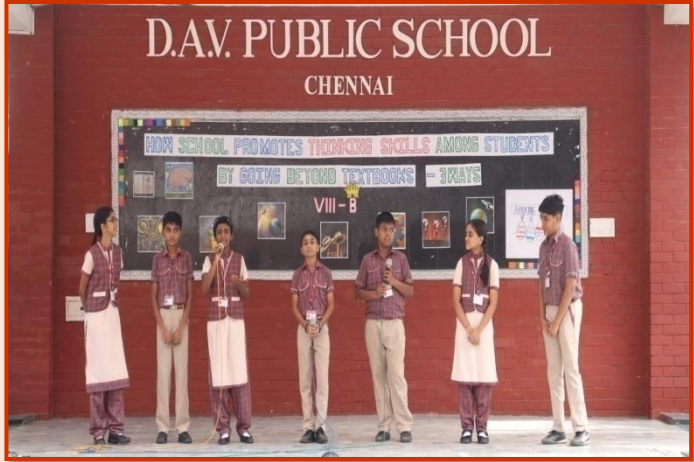

All the students with their class teacher came on stage and moved to the rhythm of “Hum Saath Saath Hain”, symbolizing togetherness of the entire class.

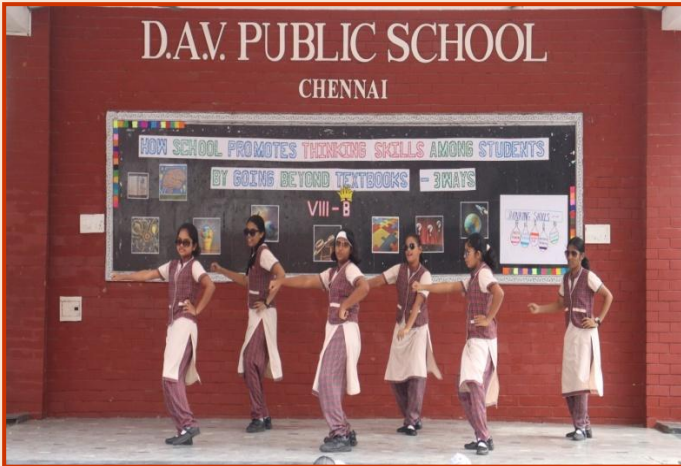

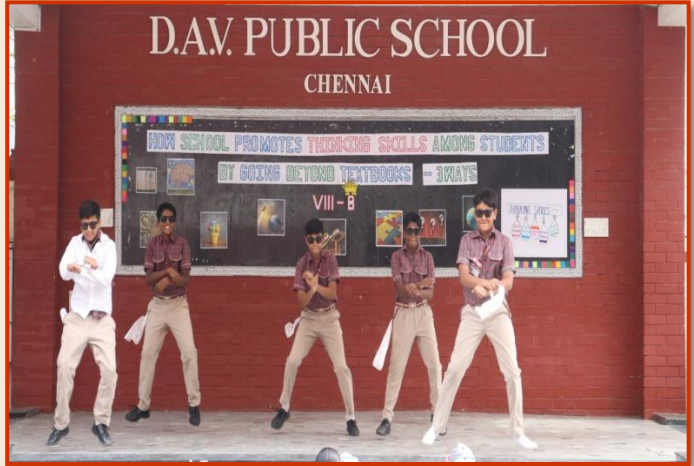
