

REPORT ON THE CELEBRATION OF “NATIONAL SPACE DAY 2024”

To commemorate the success of “Chandrayaan-3 Mission” and in an attempt to celebrate the maiden National Space Day, our School organised various activities on the theme “Touching Lives While Touching the Moon: India’s Space Saga”. It was a grand mela for a week and the activities were conducted on different dates and the closure ceremony was held on 23rd August 2024 – the National Space Day.



The students of Class I to XII were encouraged to register on the portal “Bharat on the Moon” and participate in various online activities.

Painting competitions were conducted on 21.08.2024 for the students of Classes V, VI, IX and XI on the topic “Touching Lives While Touching the Moon”. Around 120 students’ creative fingers sketched the beauty of India’s Space Saga.

A Quiz Programme “Space Trivia” was organised for the students of Class VII on 22.08.2024 in which the brilliant brains participated and won accolades.

Students of Grade VIII were given an opportunity to view the 10-grade specific modules on Chandrayaan and speak on the achievements of ISRO and its efforts in space saga.

A workshop was organised on 22nd August 2024 for the students of Class IV to showcase the specific modules on Chandrayaan and instil the interest of Space Technology in them by giving a training on the usage of Refractor Telescopes, a hands-on activity.

A grand celebration, the closing ceremony was held on 23rd August, the day which the Government of India has declared as “National Space Day”. The celebration of the maiden “National Space Day” was hosted by Class IX and XI. Eminent personalities presided over the gathering and inspired the budding astronomers by engaging them on the theme of Space.
