This is to update you of the significant changes made by the CBSE for classes IX, X, XI & XII

- CBSE has introduced value based questions in the SA-II question papers from this session 2012-13. The value based questions will be a part of Summative Assessment II from this academic session only. The questions will be based on the content of the subject.
- The value based question/ questions will carry 5 marks in a question paper of 100 marks and 3 or 4 marks in question paper of 70-90 marks in SA-II question papers hence forth.
- The next significant change is the introduction of problem solving assessment for classes IX & XI. This will also be implemented from the II term of this academic session 2012-13. It will have 60 questions of multiple choice questions and will carry a total of 90 marks.

The areas of assessment will be:

- Quantitative Reasoning.
- Qualitative Reasoning.
- Language Convention

The questions in Problem Solving Assessment will be designed in such a way so as to improve & generate higher order thinking skills. This problem Solving Assessment for classes IX and XI will be conducted in the month of January – February 2013 and the paper will be framed by CBSE.

The students have already been sensitized about the same. To discuss the current changes, the Parents whose wards study in classes IX & XI are invited to attend interaction programme on 5 November 2012 at 8.00 a.m. and those whose wards study in classes X & XII are invited for an interaction on 16 November 2012 at 8.00 a.m. in the school premises.
